

Wirral Compact Champion

Role Description

A Wirral Compact Champion has the responsibility for making the Compact known, understood and used within their individual organisation, department or sector and through local partnerships, forums and events.

Champions play a vital part in taking the Compact and its enthusiasm forward in Wirral.

As a Wirral Compact Champion, your role will be to:

- attend Compact Champions meeting/forum
- use the resources available to you in your role
- demonstrate Compact principles in action
- strive genuinely to work through differences to an acceptable resolution
- be the initial point of contact for advice and complaints affecting your organisation
- liaise with the Compact Working Group through Voluntary and Community Action Wirral, on dispute or development matters
- promote voluntary/community sector and public sector joint working and Compact principles
- facilitate communication between the public sector and voluntary/community organisations
- raise awareness in your respective sector
- demonstrate the relevance of Compact principles to your public sector and voluntary/community sector colleagues
- update on Compact development where necessary and endeavour to integrate onto other agendas
- be aware of the local and national Compact agenda

As a Compact Champion if you wish to speak on behalf of the Wirral Compact you have either:

- Been specifically asked to by members
- AND
- have had the opportunity to discuss or consult in detail with the Wirral Compact members
